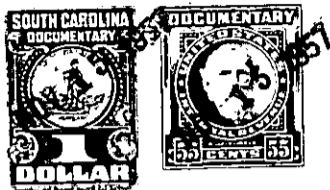

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The City of Greenville, S. C., its successors and assigns, forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land with all buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Tract 6-B, Section A, Carolina Lake Colony, according to a plat thereof, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "Y" pages 126 and 127, reference to which plat is craved for a more particular description.

THIS is the same property conveyed to Grover C. Huff and Evie Huff by deed of Carolina Lake Colony, Inc., dated September 8, 1951, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.
