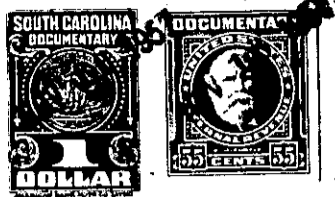

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That I, G. W. Bridwell, of the
County of Greenville,
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Fifty (\$150.00)
Dollars
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by Jennie Brooks and Larry Brooks,
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jennie Brooks and Larry Brooks,
their heirs and assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, in the Town of Travelers Rest, being shown and
designated as Lot Number Twenty Two (No. 22) on a plat of the G. W.
Bridwell property, made by T. T. Dill, Sur., recorded in Plat Book "M"
at page 129 in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, and, accord-
ing to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, courses and
distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the northern side of First Street,
joint front corner with Lot No. 23 on said plat, and running thence
in a northerly direction, 150 feet along the western line of said Lot
No. 23 to point, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 22, 23, 12 and 13;
thence in a westerly direction along the rear line of Lot No. 13, 50 ft. to
a point, joint rear corner of Lots No.s. 13, 14, 21 and 22; thence 150 ft.,
a southerly direction along the eastern line of Lot No. 21, to point on
northern side of First Street; thence in an easterly direction, 50 feet
along the northern side of said First Street to the point of beginning.
