That I, B. J. McMakin in consideration of the sum of exchange of equity in property valued at in the State aforesaid, \$2070.00 and assumption of below described mortgage DOLLARS, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee, L. M. Brown, his heirs and assigns forever:

All of that piece, parcel or tract of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate on the East side of the road that leads from the Bennetts Bridge Road to the road that leads from Simpsonville to Batesville (also known as the Augusta Road) about 11 miles east of the City of Greenville in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of the road that leads from Bennetts Bridge Road to the road that leads from Simpsonville to Batesville at the corner of the Bridges tract of land, and running thence along said Bridges line S. 72-15 E. 210 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 24-30 W. 210 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 72-15 W. 210 feet to a point in center of said road; thence with the center of said road N. 24-30 E. 210 feet to the beginning corner and containing one acre, more or less.
