All that lot, tract or parcel or land in the Town of Taylors on which a brick building now or formerly used as a drug store stand, lying on the north side of Old National Highway No. 29 about twenty yards east of Southern Bleachery Spur Tract of Piedmont & Northern Railroad, and being in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, adjoining lands on the west now or formerly owned by Gullivant Company, on the north and east by lands now or formerly owned by the grantor herein, and on the south by the right-of-way of National Highway No. 29 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
