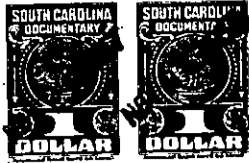

Know All Men by These Presents:

That we, W. W. Wilkins and G. Dewey Oxner, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred and 00/100 (\$700.00)----- in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Annie Mae Sullivan, her heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot One (1) on plat of Carver Court made by Piedmont Engineering Service, March, 1955, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book I I, page 107, and having according to said plat the following courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Elder Street, joint front corner of Lots 1 and 2 and running thence along the line of Lot No. 2 S. 59-21 W. 125 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 38-09 E. 63.3 feet to an iron pin; thence along line of Carver Park Subdivision S. 87-12 E. 100 feet to an iron pin on Elder Street; thence along Elder Street N. 7-36 E. 69.4 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along Elder Street N. 14-04 W. 33 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along Elder Street N. 66-10 W. 36.1 feet to the beginning corner.

The lot above described is conveyed subject to the covenants and restrictions recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 526, page 297, which are made a part hereof as fully as if set out herein, and to the public utility easement granted to the Duke Power Company, dated September 1, 1955 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 536, page 484, and to the drainage easements shown on plat of Carver Court.

The lot herein conveyed constitutes a portion of the property conveyed to us by Jessie D. Webster by deed dated September 28, 1954, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 509, page 122.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)'s Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee(s)'s Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)'s Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
