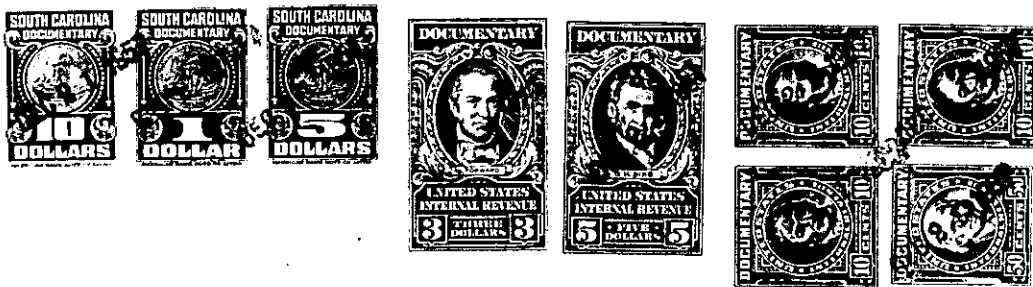

William H. Hall and Mamie Hall, their heirs and assigns: All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot No. 15 of Pine Grove Heights, plat of which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book Y, Page 87, and according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southerly side of Pine Grove Road, joint front corner of Lots 14 & 15, and running thence with the line of said lots S. 25-30 W., 158 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 64-30 E., 111 feet to stake on branch; thence with branch as the line N. 42 E., 175 feet, more or less, to a point on the southerly side of Pine Grove Road; thence with Pine Grove Road N. 66-44 W., 163.4 feet to the point of beginning.
