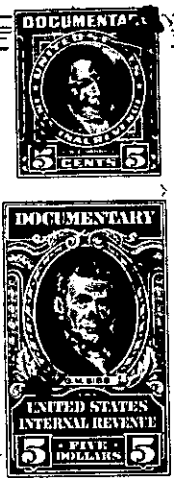


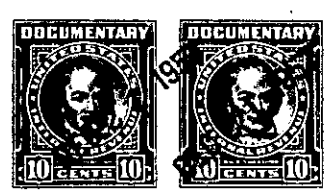

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot #3, on the Northern Side of Morris Street, as shown on plat of Leslie & Shaw, Inc., made by C. C. Jones and Associates, February 1957, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book NN, page 3, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:
