

WHEREAS, Tommie Lee Putman died on February 23, 1949 leaving as his sole heirs at law his wife, Inez G. Putman; his son, Johnny W. Putman; his daughter, Alice Griffin Putman Cain and his son, T. E. Putman, all of whom were sui juris and the estate of said Tommie Lee Putman was administered upon in the office of the Probate Court of Greenville County, South Carolina as is shown in Apartment 566, File 12 of the records of said Probate Court of Greenville County, South Carolina, and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned partition agreement was ratified and confirmed by Decree of the County Court of Greenville County, South Carolina, dated May 2, 1950 and entered in the office of the Clerk of said Court as Judgment Roll F- 443, and as a result of said Decree, deeds were executed to Claude F. WHEREAS, Lala F. Putman did die in Greenville County, South Carolina on February 22, 1958, her death thus terminating the life estate, and

WHEREAS, Claude F. Putman survived his mother, Lala F. Putman, and John Carl Putman survived his mother, Lala F. Putman, and Inez G. Putman, Johnny W. Putman, Alice Griffin Putman Cain and T. E. Putman were and are the sole living heirs of Tommie Lee Putman, and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto feel it would be to the best interest of all of them to again ratify and confirm the partition agreement entered into on or about the first day of November, 1947 and confirmed by the Decree of the County Court of Greenville County of May 2, 1950,

NOW, THEREFORE, Claude F. Putman, J. Carl Putman, Inez G. Putman, Johnny W. Putman, Alice Griffin Putman Cain
