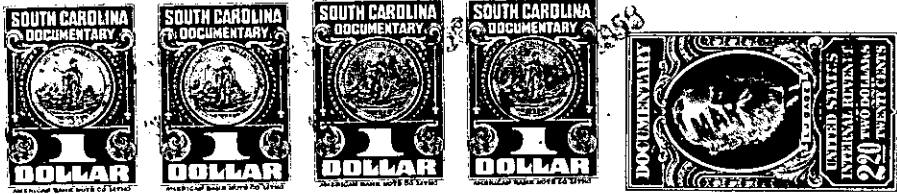

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of the road known as the Barton Road which is the northeast corner of the property hereofore conveyed by Doris S. Smith, wife of the grantor herein, to Marshall E. Wolfe and wife, Betty Black Wolfe, and is North 26 deg. 10 min. West 260 feet from an iron pin in the center of the road in the outside line of the Smith property and runs thence South 53 deg. 44 min. West 199.6 feet to an iron pin; thence North 7 deg. 46 min. West 150.9 feet to an iron pin; thence North 57 deg. 18 min. East 150 feet to an iron pin in the center of the Barton Road; thence with the center of Barton Road South 26 deg. 10 min. East 124.4 feet to the point of BEGINNING, containing one-half acre, more or less, as shown by an addendum to a plat entitled "Survey of Land for M. L. Smith, Greenville County, South Carolina" dated December 28, 1955, said addendum being made August 7, 1957, all by J. Q. Bruce, Registered Surveyor.
