Know All Men by These Presents:

That we, W. W. Wilkins and G. Dewey Oxner in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred Fifty and 00/100 (\$1550.00)----- DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Noah Louie Robinson and Catherine Smith Robinson, their heirs and assigns:

All those pieces, parcels or lots of land in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lots Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) on plat of Carver Court made by Piedmont Engineering Service March, 1955, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book I I, page 107, and having, in the aggregate, the following courses and distances according to said plat:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Elder Street joint front corner of Lots 12 and 13 and running thence along the line of Lot No. 13 S. 36-29 E. 125.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 52-31 E. 167.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 25-03 E. 36.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 50-35 W. 171.6 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 10; thence along the line of Lot No. 10 S. 48-42 W. 95 feet to an iron pin on Elder Street; thence along a curve on Elder Street S. 13-30 E. 46 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing on Elder Street along a curve S. 40-3 W. 46 feet to the beginning corner.

The lots above described are conveyed subject to the covenants and restrictions recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 526, page 297, which are made a part hereof as fully as if set out herein, and to the public utility easement granted to the Duke Power Company, dated September 1, 1955, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 536, page 484, and are further subject to the sewer and drainage easements shown on said plat.

The lots herein conveyed constitute a portion of the property conveyed to us by Jessie D. Webster by deed dated September 28, 1954, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 509, page 122.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
