That we, Ted E. Eckford and Bertie C. Eckford, in the State and County aforesaid, in consideration of the exchange of property between us and Gulf Oil Corporation this day (the receipt of which is herewith acknowledged) do hereby release and abandon unto the said Gulf Oil Corporation, a Pennsylvania Corporation having an office in the Gulf Building, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, it's successors and assigns, all that certain easement or right of way across a portion of Lot No. 1 as shown on a plat entitled "Property of Gulf Oil Corporation, Greenville, S. C.," made by Dalton & Neves, December 1957, which lot has a frontage on Butler Avenue of 73.4 feet and a frontage on Buncombe Street of 21.1 feet, which easement or right of way was created by that deed or conveyance of Belle B. Hunt to the South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 192, at page 210, to the intent that such easement or right of way and the right to use and exercise same by the said Ted E. Eckford and Bertie C. Eckford, their heirs and assigns, shall henceforth end, cease and terminate. The grantors do hereby agree and covenant that they shall forever hold harmless the said Gulf Oil Corporation, it's Successors and assigns, and the said Lot No. 1, from any and all claims or demands by the grantors, their heirs or assigns, for any easement or right of way across any portion of the said Lot No. 1.
