to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Richard Norman Budove, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as the Eastern one-half of lot No. 105 as shown on Plat No. 3 of Overbrook Land Company, recorded in Plat Book "F" at Page 218, and being more particularly described, according to said plat, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Lowndes Hill Road, joint front corner of lots Nos. 104 and 105, which pin is 637 feet in an Easterly direction from the intersection of Lowndes Hill Road and Overbrook Road, and running thence along Lowndes Hill Road, N. 76-44 W. 60 feet to an iron pin in center of lot No. 105; and running thence through center of lot No. 105, N. 15-34 E. 129.7 feet to an iron pin in center of rear line of Lot No. 105; thence S. 70-43 E. 45 feet to an iron pin in line of lot No. 104; thence with line of said lot, S. 8-52 W. 124.2 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same premises conveyed to the grantor by J. F. Scott, by deed dated April 5, 1949, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 378, at Page 525.
