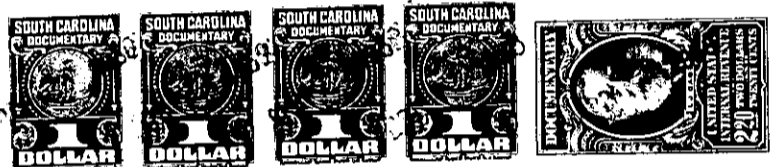
OLLIE R. M.C. Known All Men by These Presents:

J. McCrary and Marion P. McCrary, their heirs and assigns forever.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate and lying in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Paris Mountain Township being known and designated as Lot No. 6 of a subdivision known as Montroyal Hills as shown by a plat of Piedmont Engineering Service, dated August, 1957 and recorded in the R. I. C. Office for Greenville County in plat Pook KK, at page 111, and having, according to said plat, the following notes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING AT an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 6 and 7 on Pemberton Drive and running thence along said joint line S. 7-31 W. 223 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 6 and 7; thence S. 86-46 E. 180 feet along the rear line of Lot No. 6 to an iron pin; thence along the joint lines of Lots Nos. 5 and 6, N. 227.6 feet to an iron pin on Pemberton Drive; thence along Pemberton Drive N. 88-14 W. 150 feet to the point of beginning.

This property is subject to Protective Covenants as recorded in the R. I. C. Office in Deed Pook 535, at page 21; said property is also subject to a 5-foot drainage and utility easement along all side and rear lot lines as set out on said plat.
