did on the 22nd day of April, 1958, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration,

signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is PETROLEUM DISTRIBUTORS OF SUMTER, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is

To transact and carry on the business of a filling and service station for motor vehicles of all kinds; to purchase, acquire, own, hold, use, sell, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of petroleum and petroleum products, oils, greases and lubricants of all kinds; to manufacture, purchase, acquire, own, hold, use, repair, sell, mortgage, pledge, dispose of and deal in parts, tools, accessories and appliances for motor vehicles and any articles, materials, machinery, equipment and property used therefor or in connection therewith; to furnish services of all kinds in connection with motor vehicles including the servicing, repairing, lubricating, cleaning, and storing thereof; and to have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to effect any or all of the objects or purposes of the corporation.

To establish, build, lease, acquire, own, hold, use, operate, maintain and improve service stations, filling stations, garages, parking lots, shops, mills, factories, offices, buildings, structures and works of all kinds and any other properties, real and personal, suitable, necessary or convenient to any of the objects or purposes of the corporation
