PERSONALLY appeared before me Ollie S. Farnsworth and Ida S. Harrison who after being duly sworn depose and say:





That George J. Southern did marry a second time unto Nannie L. Southern and there were born unto Nannie L. Southern the following children: Elsie S. Young, Ida S. Harrison, Ollie S. Farnsworth, Leila S. Cannon and Haskell Southern. That Haskell Southern died about year 1928, prior to the death of Nannie L. Southern in 1945 as will appear by Apt. 491, File 25, in the Probate Court for Greenville County and that said Haskell Southern left as his heirs and distributees Grace S. Foster, Luther Southern, Bert Southern, his children, and his widow, Cary Southern.

That J. Luther Southern died in Wisconsin in year ^{approx.} 1930 and that J. Luther Southern did not marry and that he left as his only heir and distributee his brother, Walter L. Southern.

That Walter L. Southern died testate in Wisconsin in Vernon County as will appear by reference to information in deed book 380 at page 377 wherein he devised all of his property unto his wife, Ella Marie Southern.
