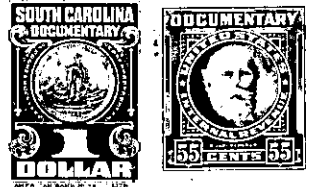

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Greenville County School
District no. 520, a body politic
and corporate under the laws of the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of
Three Hundred and no/100 Dollars,
to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the
grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained,
sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto
Woodmen of the World, Camp 566

All that piece, parcel and lot of land in Highland
Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, con-
taining one acre, more or less, on a county road
leading to Jordan Road, being bounded by land for-
merly owned by W. T. Henson, and being the same
property conveyed to school District 13, and being
recorded in the P.O. Office, Book J00-53, Volume 65,
page 14.

This being the property known as the W. T. Henson
school property.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the
said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said
Woodmen of the World, Camp 566, their successors,
Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor does hereby bind itself and its successors
jointly and severally to defend all and singular the said
Premises unto the grantee, its successors and assigns against
the grantor and its successors.
