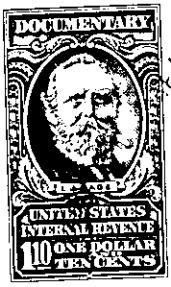

have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. E. and Alma S. Sellars, their heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as a lot marked "S", Block B, on Plat of Paris Heights, on the Easterly side of Base Hospital Road, and being 80 feet in a Northerly direction from the Northeast intersection of Base Hospital Road and Arlington Road, Plat of Paris Heights, as recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "Y", page 65; the said lot having, according to the said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Easterly side of Base Hospital Road 80 feet in a Northerly direction from the Northeast intersection of Base Hospital Road and Arlington Road, and running thence N. 72-30 E. 170 Feet to an Iron pin; thence N. 17-30 W. 80 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 9; thence S. 72-30 E. 170 feet to an iron pin on the Easterly side of Base Hospital Road; thence along the Easterly side of Base Hospital Road S. 14-02 E. 80 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
