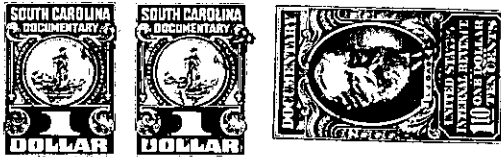

CRAIN and VERNA ELIZABETH CRAIN, Their Heirs and Assigns:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot Number 24 of a subdivision known as Woodbriar, a plat of which is of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE at Page 6, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Southeastern side of Woodbriar Court at the joint front corner of Lots 23 and 24 and running thence S 50-35 E 168.3 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 23 and 24; thence S 35-14 W 9.3 feet to a point; thence S 31-02 W 64.5 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 24 and 25; thence N 50-35 W 178.4 feet to a point on the Southeastern side of Woodbriar Court at the joint front corner of Lots 24 and 25; thence with the Southeastern side of Woodbriar Court N 39-25 E 73 feet to the point of beginning.
