All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina known as the land conveyed to S. M. Goldsmith by J. S. Goldsmith adjoining land of the said J. S. Goldsmith, W. T. Newby, and Lafayette Sammons. Beginning at a stone N.W. corner thence running S. 21 1/2 E. 4.60 to center of White Horse Road, thence with said Road N. 45 E 425 to center of Road, thence N. 29 W. 3.58 to Iron Pin, thence S. 58 W. 361 to Iron Pin the beginning corner, and containing 1.38 acres, more or less.
