to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto JAMES E. VICKERY:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 48, as shown on a plat prepared by J. Mac. Richardson, dated February, 1958, entitled "Final Plat, Glendale Heights", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book KK at page 143, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Glendale Street at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 47 and 48, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 47 N. 36-15 W. 157.9 feet to a concrete monument at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 46, 47, 48, 49 and 50; thence with the line of Lot No. 49 S. 20-31 W. 158.5 feet to an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Knox Street; thence with the curve of the intersection of Knox Street and Glendale Street, having the following chords and distances: S. 75-00 E. 54 feet to an iron pin, N. 81-31 E. 53 feet to an iron pin, N. 58-19 E. 52 feet to the point of beginning.
