Jamile J. Francis, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being on the easterly side of Pleasantburg Drive, in the City of Greenville, S. C., and being shown as the greater portion of Tract No. 1 on the plat entitled "Holiday Inn Motel," made by Piedmont Engineering Service, recorded in the RMC Office in Plat Book KK, page 145, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the easterly side of Pleasantburg Drive, which point is located 200 feet in a southwesterly direction from the southerly corner of the intersection of said Drive and Laurens Road, and also being the southwesterly corner of property now owned by the grantee, and running thence S 55-35 E 125 feet to a point; thence S 26-11 W 10 feet to a point; thence N 55-35 W 125 feet to an iron pin on the easterly side of said Drive; thence along said Drive N 26-11 E 10 feet to the point of beginning.
