All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina. situate on the Northeast side of Myers Drive in the City of Greenville, being shown and designated as Lot 11, Block 2, page 213 of the County Block Book and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Myers Drive at the joint corner of lots 37 and 40 as shown on plat of the property of G. F. Cammer, recorded in Plat Book L at page 115 and running thence with the line of Lot 37 and Lot 38, N. 40-50 E. 121.4 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot heretofore conveyed to H. S. Compton, Jr. and Margie S. Compton, by deed recorded in Deed Book 571 at page 225; thence with the line of the Compton lot, S. 44-38 E. 60.5 feet to pin; thence S. 39-23 W. 101.7 feet to pin on Myers Drive; thence with the Northeastern side of Myers Drive, N. 68-38 W. 7.7 feet to pin; thence continuing with the Northeastern side of Myers Drive, N. 58-08 W. 56 feet to the point of beginning.

Said premises being a portion of the property of G. F. Cammer who died testate leaving a will filed in Apartment 640 at file 13. The grantors are all of the sole heirs at law of Adolphus Cammer and Rosa Cammer Wyatt Radley. Rosa Cammer Wyatt Radley died January 5, 1958 in San Diego, California and Adolphus Cammer died at Greenville, S. C. intestate in September, 1956.
