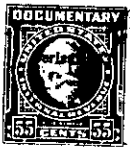

Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, T. O. Medlin, in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and No/100 (\$300.00) - - - - - in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do, grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Doyle C. Bryson, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the westerly side of U. S. Highway No. 276 about one mile southeast of the Town of Marietta and being known and designated as Lot No. 15 of Linda Acres as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE, Page 84 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the westerly side of a road known as Lake Loop, joint corner Lots Nos. 15 and 16 and running thence with the line of Lots Nos. 15 and 16 S. 50 W. 84 feet to joint corner of Lots Nos. 15, 16 and 17; thence with the joint line of Lots 17 and 15 S. 23 E. 144.6 feet to joint corner of Lots Nos. 14, 15, 17 and 18; thence with the joint line of Lots Nos. 14 and 15 N. 50 E. 120.5 feet to a point on edge of said Lake Loop; thence with Lake Loop N. 40 W. 140 feet to the beginning corner.
