 DOYLE BLACK, his heirs and assigns forever,

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Greenville Township, being known and designated as LOT NO. 43 on Chelsea Circle and being shown on plat of Subdivision known as KIRKWOOD HEIGHTS according to a Survey made by Pickell & Pickell, Engrs. October 1954 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE, at pages 110 and 111 and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Chelsea Circle at the joint front corner of Lots 4 4 and 43 and running thence along Chelsea Circle, South 72-04 West 85 feet to an iron pin; running thence in a curved line around the corner of Chelsea Circle, the chord of which is: North 86-07 West 43.1 feet to an iron pin; thence North 19-18 East 35.2 feet to a Cement Monument on Edgewood Drive; running thence along Edgewood Drive North 25-42 East 136.3 feet to an iron pin; running thence North 72-04 East 31.6 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot 44; running thence along line of Lot 44, South 17-56 East 150 feet to the point of beginning.
