

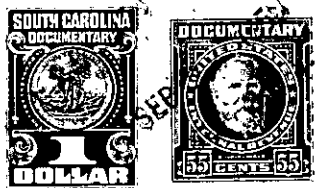

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Pearle J. Ross

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Haskell W. and Pauline Rodgers

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Haskell W. and Pauline Rodgers

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the White Horse Road:-

Beginning at a nail in the center line of the old White Horse Road and continuing S 57 deg. 22 min. E 123.5 feet to a nail in the center line of said road; thence South 67 deg. 42 min. E 100 Ft. to a nail in center line of said road; thence continuing South 71 deg. 57 min. E 100 Ft. to a nail marking intersection of old White Horse Road and Hunts Bridge Road; then North 25 deg. 3 min. E 27.3 Ft. to a nail at the intersection of center line of Hunts Bridge Road with the right of way of new White Horse Road; thence along said right of way of new White Horse Road North 61 deg. 56 min. West 100 Ft. to an iron pin; thence along aforesaid right of way North 59 deg. 18 min. West 100 Ft. to an iron pin; thence along aforesaid right of way 56 deg. 38 min. West 120.4 Ft. to an iron pin; thence along property line of Estate of J. B. Lynn South 27 deg. 30 min. West 62 Ft. to beginning point.
