in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Levis L. Gilstrap, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Paris Mountain Township being known and designated as Lot No. 22 of a subdivision of the property of Lloyd Gilstrap as shown on plat thereof prepared by Dean C. Edens, R. L. S. dated August 10, 1957 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book OO at Pages 66 and 67 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Woodys Drive, the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 21 and 22 and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 38-30 E. 200 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of said lots; thence S. 51-50 W. 100 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 23; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 21 and 23, N. 38-30 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of Woodys Drive; thence along the Southern side of Woodys Drive, N. 51-50 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning; being a portion of the property conveyed to me by Paul Hammond by his deed dated August 13, 1954 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 506 at Page 76.
