

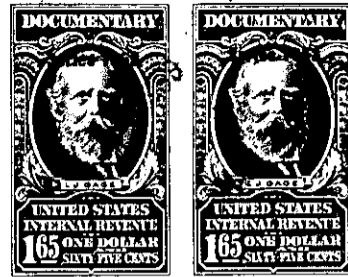

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, located about three miles northwest from Taylors, lying on the south side of the Taylors-Reid School Road, being bounded on the east by lands of Cannada, on the south and west by other lands of myself, and on the north by the said road, and being a part of the same land that was conveyed to me by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 134 at page 177, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning on a nail and stopper in the center of the said road, joint corner of the Cannada lot, and runs thence with the Cannada line S.-4-05 E. 307.5 feet to an iron pin in settlement road, Cannada corner; thence with the settlement road S.46-45 W. 157.6 feet to an iron pin in the said road; thence N. 0-30 W. 6 feet to an iron pin on the line and on the bank of the said road, then continueing with the same course, N. 0-30 W. for a total distance of 439 feet to a nail and stopper in the center of the said Taylors-Reid School Road (iron pin back on line at 19 feet); thence with the said road S. 75-30 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner, and containing Ninety Two One Hundredths (0.92) of one acre, more or less.
