QUITCLAIM DEED

TRAMMELL in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 (\$1.00) Dollars, to the grantors in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantees (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, quitclaimed and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, quitclaim and release unto FAUST NICHOLSON, T. FRANK HUGUENIN and JOHN T. DOUGLAS, their heirs and assigns forever, all their right, title and interest in and to the following described real estate, to-wit:

All those pieces, parcels or lots of land, together with buildings and improvements situate thereon, situate, lying and being at the southeasterly corner intersection of Mills Avenue Extension and Edgewood Drive (formerly known as Owens Street), Greenville County, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot Nos. 1 and 2 on a plat of the subdivision of Langley Heights, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in June, 1937, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "I", at page 77, being partially shown on a plat prepared by R.K. Campbell dated February 7, 1949, recorded in the said R.M.C. Office for said County and State in Plat Book "V", at page 97, and being described by metes and bounds, to-wit:
