KEELER, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot 29 Block E on plat of Paris Heights recorded in Plat Book Y, Page 65, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having according to a more recent survey by R. W. Dalton dated December 10, 1958, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
