All my right, title and interest to the undivided interest in the estate of Joe Pickett, who died intestate, whose unadministered estate consists of the following described property:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, adjoining lands of Mrs. Charlie Phillips on the north, other lands of the grantors on the east and south, and lands of Taylors Lumber Company on the west, and has the following metes and bounds:
