Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, Robert A. Bailey in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of twelve hundred and forty dollars (\$1240.00) and DOLLARS, the assumption of the below described mortgage to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee, William J. Locke, his heirs and assigns forever:

All of that piece, parcel or tract of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate on the East side of the road that leads from the Bennetts Bridge Road to the road that leads from Simpsonville to Batesville (also known as the Augusta Road) about 11 miles east of the City of Greenville, in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of the road that leads from Bennetts Bridge Road to the road that leads from Simpsonville to Batesville at the corner of the Bridges tract of land, and running thence along said Bridges line S. 72-15 E. 210 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 24-30 W. 210 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 72-15 W. 210 feet to a point in center of said road; thence with the center of said road N. 24-30 E. 210 feet to the beginning corner and containing one acre, more or less. The above described land is bounded on the north by the land now or formerly of Bridges; on the East and South by land now or formerly of Bonnie G. Smith, and on the West by the road that leads from the Bennetts Bridge Road to the road that leads from Simpsonville to Batesville.

As part of the consideration for the within conveyance the grantee assumes that mortgage on the above described property given by B. J. McMakin to Jack Spalding Jr., which mortgage is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 659, at page 410.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
