That I, James B. Arrowood in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE AND 25/100-----DOLLARS, and assumption of mortgage to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Joe Pearson, his heirs and assigns:

ALL that lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina known and designated as Lot #27 of a subdivision known as Grand-View as shown by a plat thereof made by J. Mac Richardson, March, 1957 and recorded in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office in Plat Book "KK", at page 93, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Crestmore Drive at the joint corner of Lots #26 and #27 and running thence with the southern side of Crestmore Drive, S. 74-17 E., 60 feet to a pin at the corner of Lot #28; thence with the line of Lot #28, S. 15-43 W., 165 feet to a pin in the rear line of Lot #6; thence with the rear lines of Lots #6 and #7, N. 72-35 E., 60.02 feet to a pin at the corner of Lot #26; thence with the line of Lot #26, N. 15-43 W., 163.2 feet to the beginning corner.

The grantee assumes payment of a mortgage to Fidelity Federal Savings and Loan Association with a balance as of 11/19/58 of \$5,978.75.
