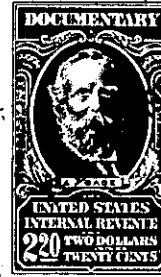
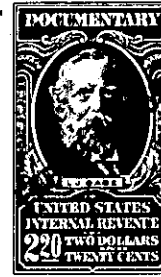

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee S hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Wallace B. Barnett and Dale W. Barnett, their heirs and assigns:

All that certain lot of land situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and known and designated as Lot No. 19, Block D, as shown on a plat of the village of S. Slater and Sons, Inc., made by J. E. Serrine and Company, Engineers, on July 10, 1940, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "K" at Pages 63, 64 and 65, and according to said plat is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Webster Street, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 19 and 20, Block B, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 20 S. 53-46 E. 119.72 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 12; thence with the rear line of Lots Nos. 12 and 13, N. 38-40 E. 70-07 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 53-46 W. 122.7 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Webster Street; thence with the east side of Webster Street S. 36-14 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
