To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, in and by an Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, entitled "An act to provide for the incorporation and regulation of certain corporations," approved the twenty-ninth day of April, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, and the supplements thereto, the Governor of this Commonwealth is authorized and required to issue Letters Patent to all corporations formed under the provisions of said acts, contained within the annual class named therein.

And whereas, the stipulations and conditions in said Act of the General Assembly and the supplements thereto have been fully complied with

by the said corporation, and the same are in conformity with the Constitution and laws of said Commonwealth in such case made and provided, I do by these

Letters Patent, full power and authority, do hereby give, grant and confirm unto the said corporation, full power and authority, to exercise the powers, privileges and franchises therein expressed, and to do all such things as may be necessary to carry the same into effect.

And I do hereby certify that the said corporation is duly organized and is in conformity with the Constitution and laws of said Commonwealth in such case made and provided.
