

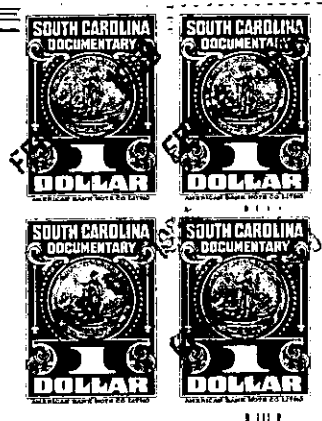

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W. R. Lindsey,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantees

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William Kirby Lindsey, Beatrice Lindsey Coster, Ruth Lindsey, Kate Lindsey Watson, Thurman Waddy Lindsey, Ruby Lindsey Green, their heirs and assigns forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING AT a Sourwood 3 X o.m. (gone) and running thence N. 83 E. 10.00 chains to a stone 3 X o.m.; thence running N. 30 1/2 E. 3.40 chains to a large poplar 3 X o.m.; thence along branch line to a stake 3 X o.m.; thence N. 7 1/2 W. 9.07 chains to a stone 3 X o.m.; thence running S. 72 1/2 W. 40.15 chains to a stake 3 X n.m.; thence with branch line 3.28 chains to the beginning corner, and containing 29 acres, more or less.

THIS PROPERTY adjoins lands now or formerly belonging to B. M. Lindsey, J. L. Lindsey, Gideon Moon, and others, and being the same tract of land conveyed to the grantor herein by J. A. Chastain by deed recorded on the 12th day of April, 1919, in the R.M.C. Office of Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 49, at page 30.

ALSO, ALL THAT certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING AT an iron pin with the McMillan corner of the Chastine Branch and running thence S. 00 E. 23.50 chains to the Lindsey and McMillan stone corner; thence running N. 29 E. 14.50 chains to an iron pin on the river bank; thence up the South fork of the Tyger river 19.70 chains to the mouth of the Chastine Branch; thence up the said Chastine Branch to the beginning corner, and containing 30 acres, more or less.
