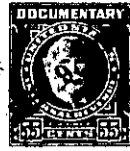

Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, L. S. Flanagan-- in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Twenty Five & 00/100 (\$325.00)----- DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee, J. R. Brown, his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as the Southeast part of Lot No. 30 of Section B, as shown on plat of property of H. H. and Alice M. Willis by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, November 1939, recorded in Plat Book J, at pages 150 and 151, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the joint line of Lots 29 and 30 of Section B, said point being 150 feet S. 75 E. from the joint front corner of said lots on Willis Avenue; thence S. 75 E. 150 feet to stake at joint corner Lots 29-30-17 and 18; thence along line of Lot 17, N. 36-15 E. 100 feet to stake, joint rear corner Lots 17 and 16; thence in a Western direction 190 feet to a point; thence in a Southern direction 100 feet to the beginning.

ALSO the right of ingress and egress over and along a strip 10 feet wide the center of which begins at a point on the Eastern side of Willis Avenue 77 feet N. 19-32 E. from the joint front corner of Lots 29 and 30 of Section B as shown on the above mentioned plat and running thence in an Eastern direction to the Northwestern corner of the lot of land described above; thence along the Northern line of the lot described above 190 feet to a stake joint rear corner of Lots 16 and 17. It is understood and agreed that this right of way is to be used by the grantor and grantee and any other party who may hereafter own a part of said Lot No. 30 of Section B.

The above described property is the same conveyed to me by J. A. Jones by deed Dated December 17th, 1952, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County S. C., in Deed Book 469, Page 37.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
