in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William S. Freeman, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Butler Township, on the west side of the Greenacre Road and being known as Lot No. 8 of the property of E. Godfrey Webster as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book K at Page 39, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west side of Greenacre Road, at corner of Lot No. 9, which point is 166.75 feet south of the southwest corner of the intersection of Greenacre Road and the Laurens Road, and running thence along the west side of Greenacre Road, S. 31-30 W. 66.6 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 7; thence along the line of Lot No. 7, N. 55-30 W. 163.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 34-30 E. 66.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 55-30 E. 160 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to us by C.
