to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Edgar W. Teasley, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being on the westerly side of Fleetwood Drive, near the City of Greenville, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 45 on the plat of Magnolia Acres as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book GG, page 133, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the westerly side of Fleetwood Drive at a point 142 feet north of the northerly corner of the intersection of Fleetwood Drive and Cool Brook Drive, said pin being the joint corner of Lots 45 and 46, and running thence along the joint line of said Lots N 79-15 W 128 feet to an iron pin, common corner of Lots 45, 46 and 47; thence with the line of Lot 47 N 00-15 E 101.7 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 44 and 45; thence with the joint line of said lots N 83-33 E 145.6 feet to an iron pin on the westerly side of Fleetwood Drive; thence with the westerly side of Fleetwood Drive S 10-09 W 100 feet to the point of beginning.

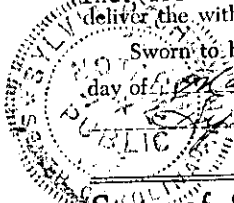
