KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, John L. White of Greenville, South Carolina, in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Mrs. Lena White

All of my right, Title and Interest and Equity in a contract for Title executed on October 25, 1948, between me and W. G. Serrine as to a certain parcel and lot of land known as No. 13 Endell Street, located in the City and County of Greenville, and being more particularly described as follows:

A CERTAIN lot of tract of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in the town of West Greenville, known as Lot no. 13 of subdivision of property of Minnie B. Christopher, see plat recorded RMC office Plat Book U, page 113, and described as follows: BEGINNING at an iron pin on east side of Endell Street at corner of Lot no. 12, which point is 146.8 feet north of intersection of Doe Street, and running thence along east side of Endell Street, N. 24-36 E. 43.7 feet to iron pin at intersection of a 12-foot alley; thence along the south side of said alley, S. 66-20 E. 91 feet, more or less, to an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 14; thence along line of Lot No. 14, S. 26-07 W. 43.7 feet to an iron pin at rear corner of lot No. 12; thence along line of lot No. 12, N. 66-20 W. 89.8 feet to the beginning corner, being the same conveyed to W. G. Serrine this day by Minnie E. Christopher, recorded in Volume 363, Page 163, Office of the R. M. C.

This is the same contract verbally assigned or assigned in writing to my Assignee, Lena White, about the time that a Foreclosure suit was commenced against me as a party dependent on or about the 25th day of March, 1954.
