BEGINNING at the southeasterly corner of Stone Avenue and Vannoy Street, and running thence along the southerly side of Stone Avenue S 71-50 E 62 feet; thence S 20-19 W 150 feet to Moffett's corner; thence N 71-50 W 62 feet to a point on the easterly side of Vannoy Street; thence along Vannoy Street in a northerly direction 150 feet to the point of beginning.
