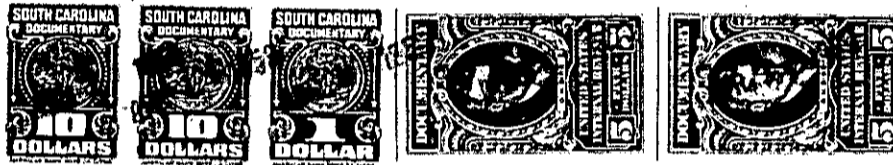

C. in Plat Book Y, page 111, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwesterly side of White Oak Drive, joint front corner of Lots 39 and 40, and running thence along the common line of said lots S 69-43 W 119.9 feet to a point in the rear line of Lot 32; thence along the rear line of Lots 32 and 31 S 24-56 E 83.2 feet to a point in the rear line of Lot 31; thence N 63-44 E 114 feet to an iron pin on the southwesterly side of White Oak Drive; thence along the southwesterly side of White Oak Drive N 20-43 W 71 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
