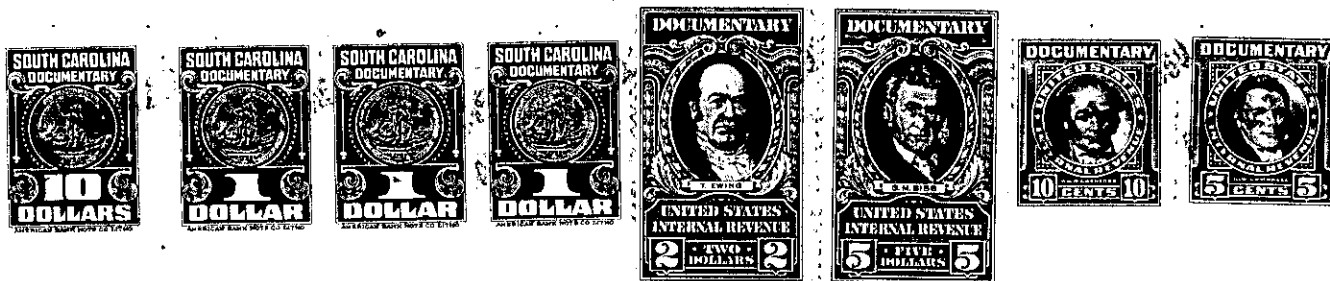


EXCLUDED from tracts 2 and/or 3 is a lot containing one acre, more or less, conveyed by the heirs of W. V. Campbell to Davington Baptist Church by several deeds, two of which are recorded in Vol. 347, at page 253 and Vol. 503 at page 474.

The foregoing premises were owned by W. V. Campbell who departed this life intestate in July 1930, leaving as his sole heirs at law his widow, Virginia T. Campbell, who died intestate on November 10, 1957 (her sole heirs at law being the children of W. V. Campbell and Virginia T. Campbell) and the following children: Cora C. Peden, Nannie C. Balcombe, Bessie C. Epps, Beatrice C. Chastain, Grace C. Jenkins, Ruth C. Tucker, W. Grady Campbell, James P. Campbell, Furman Campbell, Carl Campbell, Maude Campbell Baker and Arthur Leon Campbell. Arthur Leon Campbell subsequently departed this life intestate leaving as his sole heirs at law, his widow, Carrie Campbell and his children Ralph C. Campbell, Sara C. Woods, Kathryn C. Chiles, Vivian C. Culbertson, Arthur Leon Campbell, Loraine C. Griffin, Louise Campbell Brook, Mindel Campbell, Peggy C. Skelton and Charles Campbell, the latter having died intestate, unmarried and without children, leaving as his sole heirs his mother, brothers and sisters. Grace C. Jenkins departed this life intestate leaving as her sole heirs at law her children, Mary C. Thigpen, James E. Jenkins and Dwight Jenkins and her husband, James E. Jenkins, who subsequently died intestate leaving as his sole heirs at law the three named children. Maude Campbell Baker departed this life intestate leaving as her sole heir at law her son Edward E. Baker.
