Edgar W. Teasley, his heirs and assigns forever:

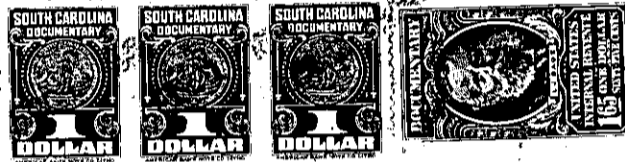

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southerly side of Fleetwood Drive at a point 204.4 feet east of the southeasterly corner of the intersection of Fleetwood Drive and Cool Brook Drive, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots 35 and 36, and running thence along the joint line of said lots S 25-49 E 198.3 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot 51; thence with the line of said lot S 87-21 E 41.8 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot 41; thence with the line of Lot 41 N 40-28 E 52.6 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 36 and 37; thence with the joint line of said lots N 25-49 W 197 feet to an iron pin on the southerly side of Fleetwood Drive; thence along the southerly side of Fleetwood Drive S 64-11 W 85 feet to the point of beginning.
