All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about three miles south west from Greer, lying on the northern side of the old Chick Springs west from Greer, lying on the northern side of the old Chick Springs Road, and being a part of Lot No. 71 as shown on Plat of Property of Road, and being a part of Lot No. 71 as shown on Plat of Property of T. W. Dill Estate prepared by S. C. Moon, October, 1940, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit: \
