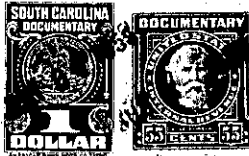

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Homer Styles, his heirs and assigns: All the right, title, interest and estate of Willie Earl Bruster in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Oneal Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 1/4 acres, more or less, situate on the eastern side of the road leading through Tract No. 4 on plat of the Estate of J. T. Styles, which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book I at page 130, and being all of the property conveyed to James Bruster by deed recorded in Deed Book 239 at page 263, with the exception of such property which was conveyed to Edward Gordon Able, et al, by deeds recorded in Deed Book 571 at pages 77 and 102.

The said James Bruster departed this life intestate on January 8, 1956 (Apartment 644, File 22) leaving as his sole heirs at law and distributees his widow, Eloise Bruster; his children, George Bruster, James Earl Bruster, John L. Bruster, J. W. Bruster, Mattie Lee Bruster (Jones); Margaret Bruster Barton, and a grandson, Willie Earl Bruster.
