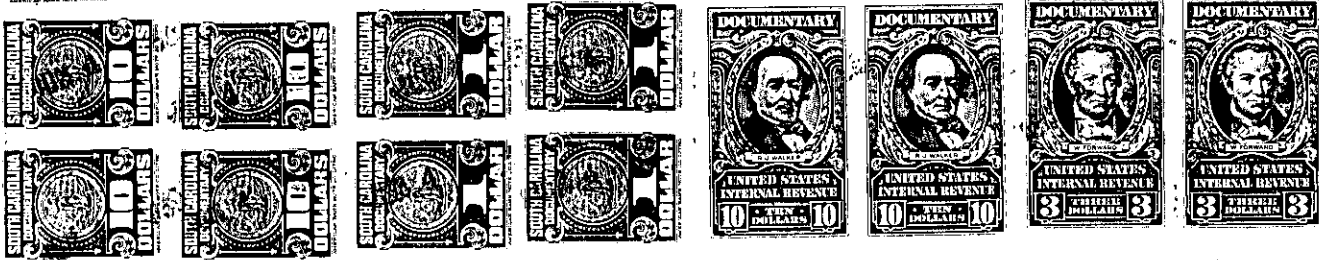
Know All Men by These Presents:

Rogers, her Heirs and Assigns, forever:

All those pieces, parcels or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lots Nos. 39 and 40 of Indian Hills, plat of which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ, Page 11, and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Hunts Bridge Road at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 40 and 41, and running thence with the line of said lots N. 82-35 E., 180 feet; thence S. 7-25 E., 200 feet to the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 38 and 39; thence with the line of said lots S. 82-35 W., 180 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Hunts Bridge Road; thence with Hunts Bridge Road N. 7-25 W., 200 feet to the beginning.
