

STATEMENT OF EXTENSION OF FILING FOR RECORD

The undersigned, State Mutual Life Assurance Company of America, hereby makes affidavit as follows:

1. By instrument dated August 29, 1956 State Mutual Life Assurance Company of America, a Massachusetts corporation, acquired from Draper Corporation, a Maine corporation with its principal place of business in Hopedale, Massachusetts, all of the right, title and interest of Draper Corporation in, to and under a certain Lease Agreement dated June 11, 1956 and recorded July 3, 1956, in Deed Book 835, pages 69 et seq. of Greenville County, South Carolina, between Draper Corporation as Lessor and J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc. as Lessee, and in and to the personal property covered thereby, and State Mutual Life Assurance Company of America is now the holder of said Lease Agreement with Draper Corporation.
2. Said Lease Agreement is now in full force and effect.
3. Said Lease Agreement provides for a rental of items of machinery and equipment to J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc. for a period of five years from July 23, 1956, in consideration of quarterly payments of rent by J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc. and other covenants set forth in said Lease Agreement.
4. The rental payments remaining unpaid under said Lease Agreement aggregate \$ 133,348.22 on the date hereof.
5. The filing for record of said Lease Agreement is hereby extended as provided by law.

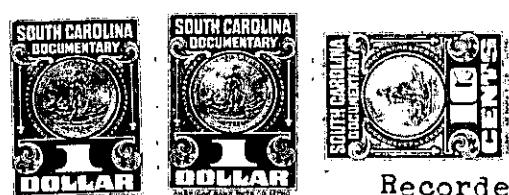
