to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto BILLY MARTIN AND PATSY C. MARTIN:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southern side of Lermann Drive, Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 20 as shown on a plat of Section 2, Fairfield Acres, prepared by C.O. Riddle, dated January, 1956, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book FF at page 459, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Lermann Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 19 and 20, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 19 S. 2-25 W. 125.3 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of property now or formerly of W.A. Stepp N. 87-48 W. 75 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 21; thence with the line of Lot No. 21 N. 2-25 E. 125.6 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of Lermann Drive; thence with the Southern side of Lermann Drive S. 87-35 E. 75 feet to the point of beginning.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of Eddie W. Gregory and Minnie B. Gregory, dated July 14, 1958, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 616 at page 536.
