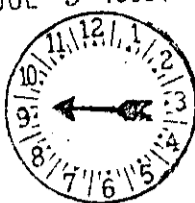

these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said ANNIE L. YARBOROUGH  
my undivided one-half (1/2) interest in and to

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 631 on Plat  
No. 7 of the property of the Tryon Development Company, known as Lake  
Lanier, made by George Kershaw, C.E., and duly recorded in the Office  
of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book  
"H" at page 3, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern edge of Lake Shore Drive  
at the Northern corner of Lot No. 632 and running with Lake Shore Drive
