to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Elsie Gertrude Davis and William Ray Davis, their heirs and assigns, forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, on the E/S of the South Saluda river, W/S of Sherwood Road, and having, according to a plat of survey made by R. B. Bruce, surveyor, June 8, 1957, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING on the W/S of Sherwood Road, joint corners of Lots 3 and 4 and running with the joint lines of said lots S 41-16 W 112.8 feet to a point on the edge of South Saluda river; thence with said river N 48-39 W 93.7 feet to an iron pin, joint corners of lots 2 and 3; thence with the joint lines of lots 2 and 3, N 45-42 E 113 feet to a point on the edge of said road; thence with said road S 48-44 E 85 feet to the beginning corner, being all of Lot no. Three (3) as shown on said plat.
